Greetings and Happy New Year—wow here it is another year for the HRGC Ruffed Grouse. We wish you the very best!

Frank's Trap Report: While trap season is still several months away, we held our Annual New Year's Day Trap Shoot. Again, the weather gods favored us with above freezing temperatures but some gustier winds at the start of the session. Fortunately, the winds slowed down as the day progressed.

We had a good turnout with 11 shooters and 27 rounds shot. Mike Galusha shot the first 25 of the year in round 3 and had the best overall score for the day with an outstanding 97/100. Several of us attempted to keep the pace, but we fell short. One third of the rounds shot were 20 or higher. Thanks to all the members and guests who supported us.

Our demented trap setter lowered the Pat Trap one notch from last season to throw a "flatter" target than the nice, loftier birds we threw last season. This didn't seem to do much on the first couple of rounds as the prevailing Knox tailwinds picked up several birds and certainly lofted them skyward. One veteran shooter did comment that he seemed to miss several birds by shooting over them. The trap will remain one notch lower until after the President's Day shoot after which a decision will be made as to whether to raise the trap or leave it set where it is.

Hopefully we'll have a pleasant day on Sunday, February 19th for our President's Day Trap Shoot. Please mark your calendars and plan to join us.

We will be making another announcement at the February meeting along with some demonstrations on how everything will work. A very special thanks to the team of folks that worked on this live fire testing 100's of rounds of many different kinds of ammo and calibers to come up with safe standards on allowable use. We are counting on you to strictly adhere to what is laid out in the policies, because a lot of research has been done for your safety. New cameras are installed, and the window coverings are complete so both ranges can now operate simultaneously.
